Also, because you can't hold the camera as you normally would, stabilized by keeping your arms close to your body, the unnatural body position can cause the camera to shake.

The clutch mechanism makes it possible to switch between AF and MF by simply re-positioning the focus ring. Pull the clutch towards you to activate manual focus and push it away from you to activate autofocus. Note that this works regardless of the focus mode you have selected in the camera menu. The MF clutch overrides the camera setting.

Manual focus tips. First set your DSLR lens to autofocus (AF) and focus on the closest object near the one your trying to photograph. For example, in the hover fly image above, I firstly set the autofocus on the flower, then turned the lens switch to MF for manual focussing.
