How to open the VBA environment. You can access the VBA environment in Excel 2013 by opening the Microsoft Visual Basic for Applications window.. First, be sure that the DEVELOPER tab is visible in the toolbar in Excel.. The DEVELOPER tab is the toolbar that has the buttons to open the VBA editor and create Form/ActiveX Controls like buttons, checkboxes, etc.

### MS Excel 2013: Open the Visual Basic Editor

Close Excel, then delete your Personal.xlwb file. It is usually located in C:\Users\USERNAME\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Excel\XLSTART\ Now restart Excel and record a simple macro, just select a cell and stop recording. That will create a new Personal.xlwb file for you. Hit Alt+F11 and insert modules and paste in your saved macros.

### Macros disabled in Excel 2013 - Microsoft Community

Open Excel to a new Workbook and choose the Developer tab in the ribbon. Choose Record Macro and accept all of the default settings in the Record Macro dialog box, including Macro1 as the name of the macro and This Workbook as the location. Choose OK to begin recording the macro. Note how the button text changes to Stop Recording.
